

SAFER ROADS HUMBER – ENFORCEMENT SCHEDULE – UPTO 8th AUGUST 2010

Safer Roads Humber will be publishing the enforcement schedule on a weekly / fortnightly basis. This enables the Partnership to be more responsive to the local traffic conditions. The Partnership uses a range of enforcement equipment to ensure that the speed limit is enforced at safety camera sites both during the day and night.

Safer Roads Humber plan to operate mobile safety cameras at these locations on these dates, weather permitting. However, this is the minimum speed enforcement undertaken and Officers can visit any of the Partnership's other sites, on any day of the week including evenings and weekends. The Partnership can enforce at any location along a safety camera route. Please drive safely and watch your speed at all times. Humberside Police reserves the right to enforce speed limits on any road, at any time. Those who exceed the speed limit risk prosecution.

National speed limits – the maximum speed limits for cars and motorcycles is 60mph on single carriageways and 70mph on dual carriageways, less for other types of vehicles. For further details visit www.highwaycode.gov.uk

Please remember that Safer Roads Humber has fixed cameras located in the 30mph limits on Clough Road, Spring Bank West & Stoneferry Road in Hull; in the 40mph limit on Beverley Road, Hull; in the 50mph limit on A46 Laceby bypass; and in national speed limits on A1079 Beverley bypass and A1079 Market Weighton.

Safer Roads Humber is enforcing along the A614 from Howden Road, Howden to Holme on Spalding Moor and Driffield to Nafferton.
